

How to sign

It's better to use the title case format of the name on license ('John Henry Doe') but any name is a legal fiction so in the end, it isn't a concern. The key is that you write "By:" which differentiates the signer from the name, thereby showing there are two parties. Regards mark

"By:" (as in by accommodation to maintain separation/diversity

between myself & the corporate legal title) and All rights reserved.

Mark says to write 'All Rights Reserved' FIRST because he's had the police snatch the paper away immediately after signing before

he could write the rest!!
